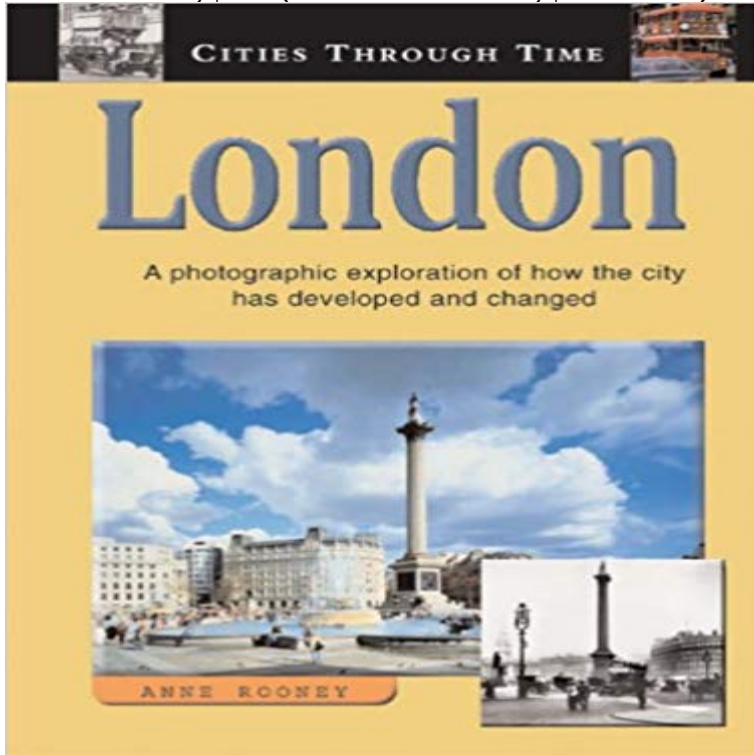


# London: A Photographic Exploration of How the City Has Developed and Changed (Cities Through Time)
