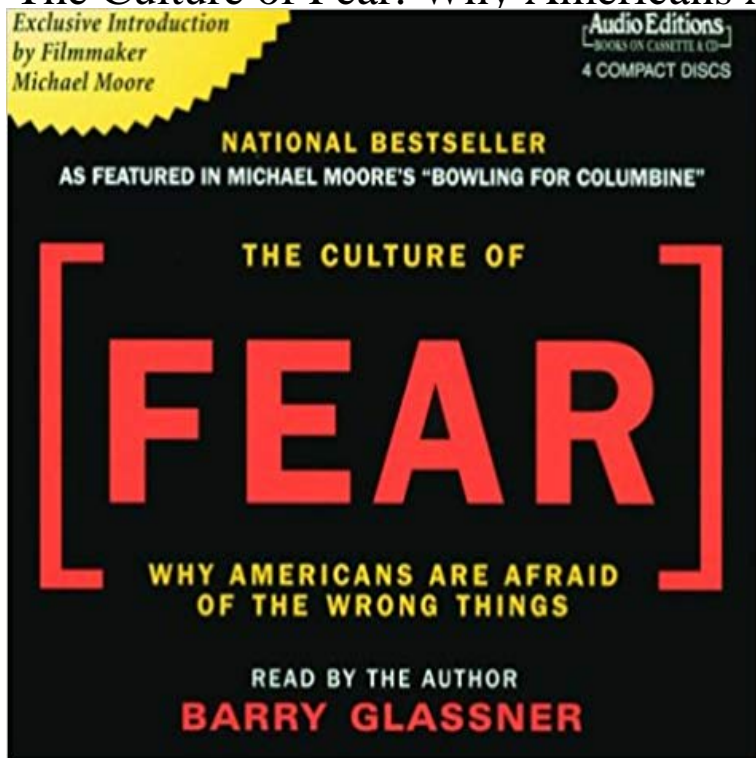


The Culture of Fear: Why Americans Are Afraid of the Wrong Things
