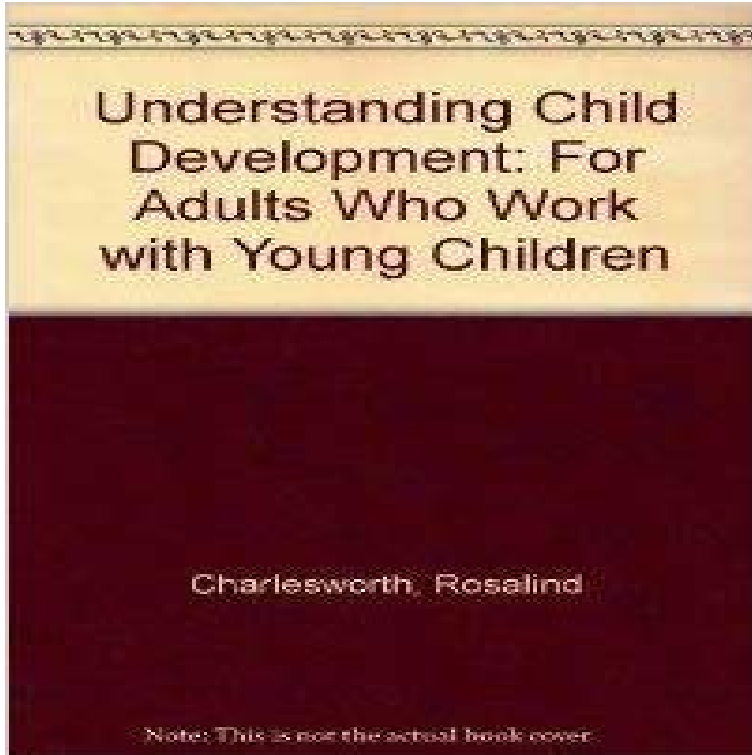


# Understanding Child Development: For Adults Who Work With Young Children
